Cricket

Cricket brings strategy and skill together in a beloved sport rich in tradition and passion. Masters teams will showcase batting prowess, bowling finesse, and brilliant fielding in exciting matchups.

Competition dates

The cricket competition will be conducted in accordance with international cricket regulations and adapted to the specific needs of the Open Masters Games Abu Dhabi 2026 (OMGAD2026), ensuring fairness, safety, and competitiveness across all age categories.

The provisional Cricket competition schedule for OMGAD2026 is as follows:

Team Structure

Teams will consist of a minimum of 11 starting players. However, there is no maximum number of players on a team.

Competition format

The Cricket competition at OMGAD2026 will follow the **T10 format – 10 overs per side**, in accordance with international limited-overs rules.

Athletes will compete within the appropriate age categories as outlined by the OMGAD2026 age group guidelines.

In line with the sport-specific rules, an athlete must compete in their designated age group, with their age determined as of 31 December 2026. For example, if you turn 40 by 31 December 2026, you will compete in the 40+ age category.

If there are insufficient entries in an age category, categories may be combined to conduct a viable competition. The awarding of medals will not be affected, that is, individuals will still be awarded medals in the age category in which they originally entered.

Grade Definitions

Competitive: Teams who have three or more players at international level will be considered as competitive standard and should enter that competition.

Recreational: Teams who play in local recreational or social leagues will be considered recreational level.

Scoring

In the OMGAD2026 cricket competition, scores will be determined by the total runs accumulated by each team in their allotted overs. The team with the highest score at the end of the match wins. In the event of a tie at the end of a match, tiebreaker rules may be implemented, such as a super over or other pre-agreed method to determine the winner. Throughout the tournament, players' individual performances, including runs scored, wickets taken, and overall team performance, will be tracked for ranking purposes. Rankings will be updated after each round, with teams placed according to their win-loss record and total runs. If teams are tied in their rankings, net run rate (NRR) may be used as a deciding factor to determine which team advances to the finals or next round.

The final standings in the competition will be determined by the outcomes of the final rounds, with the highest-ranked teams earning the opportunity to compete for medals.

Equipment

Athletes participating in the cricket competition at the OMGAD2026 are expected to bring and use their own personal cricket equipment. This includes, but is not limited to pads, gloves, helmets, abdominal guards, and appropriate footwear. All gear should be in good condition and suitable for competitive play. While the organisers will provide match balls, bats and team bibs, if necessary, personal equipment is the responsibility of each athlete. Participants are also encouraged to ensure their equipment meets safety standards, and to avoid any items that could pose a risk to themselves or others during play.

Technical Meeting

One representative from each team is expected to attend the Cricket Technical Meeting prior to the commencement of the event. Further information will be confirmed closer to the start of the competition.

Technical delegate

The Technical Delegate, endorsed by Emirates Cricket Board, will oversee the implementation of all sport specific rules and requirements at the Games.
